

'DEPLORABLY DANGEROUS' EMBANKMENT

TIVERTON Trades Council is joining in the campaign to get the Westexe halt railway embankment cleaned up.

At a recent meeting, Mr Fred Willis stated: "It's in a deplorable and dangerous state, and something must be done about it quickly. There was a time when this was the best kept property in Westexe."

Mr Willis proposed that the district council be asked who was responsible for cleaning up "the mess."

He feared that the bill for cleaning up would fall on the local ratepayers, and thought that if it did it would be "all wrong."

They were entitled to some explanation of why the embankment had been left in such "a terrible mess."
